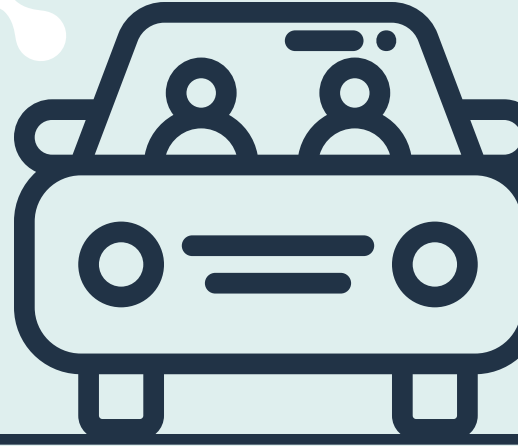

# CARPOOLING RECOMMENDATIONS



**Workers should REDUCE carpooling as much as possible.**

According to the directives of the Quebec government, people who do not live at the same address should not carpool together.

### If other options are not available, you must:

- Always carpool with the same person.
- Keep the number of people in the car to a minimum.
- Provide new certified masks for travel at the end of shifts.
- Keep a logbook of carpoolers.

### Carpooling Instructions:

- No worker with COVID-19 symptoms should carpool.
- Everyone must wear a certified mask (because two-metre distancing is not possible).
- The passenger must sit in the back of the vehicle at an angle to the driver.
- Sharing items is not allowed.
- No passenger should eat, drink, or smoke during the trip.
- The windows should be opened a few times during the trip to ventilate the passenger compartment.
- Using the air recirculation setting is not recommended.
- Surfaces touched by the passenger must be disinfected before another passenger uses the vehicle.
