

FLUOROSCOPY | Arthrogram, joint injection, facet injection and nerve block.

Your physician has prescribed an arthrography, and articular, peripheral, and periradicular infiltration. The purpose of the exam is to view the joints following the injection of a contrast product into the joint cavity under fluoroscopic guidance to locate the exact site of the injection. To this end, a needle is inserted, its position is verified, and the radiologist injects the medication (cortisone) in a specific site in the joints (articular infiltration), the facet joint of a vertebra in the spine (facet injection) into the foramen/periradicular sheath (periradicular infiltration).

ABOUT THE EXAM

These examinations are by appointment only. The length of the examination varies case by case (preparation, examination and observation). Plan to spend half a day for the procedure.

ALLERGIES | DIABETES

If you are diabetic or allergic to contrasting dyes (iodine), latex, or lidocaine:

- Inform your physician. He will give you specific instructions to follow.
- Notify the administrative officer who will call you to confirm your appointment.
- Furthermore, upon arriving at the medical imaging department, notify the technologists.

ON THE DAY OF THE EXAM

- Plan to spend half a day for your exam.
- You will be asked to put on a hospital gown.
- Before the exam, X-rays may be taken of the site to be infiltrated.

AFTER THE EXAM

- It is normal to have a swelling sensation in the infiltrated joint.
- Keep the adhesive bandage on and dry (no bath, lake, pool, spa) until the following day.
- If you feel pain, apply ice on the injection site. Acetaminophen tablets (Tylenol) can be taken every 4 to 6 hours, but avoid ibuprofen (Advil) or Acetylsalicylic acid (Aspirin).

PREPARING FOR THE EXAM

No preparation is necessary for this exam.

BRING THE FOLLOWING FOR THE EXAM

- A valid health insurance card (to avoid paying for this test).
- A valid hospital card (if needed, you will have to go to the reception and admission department to get a card before your appointment).
- A list of your medications, if required.
- A bag for your personal items. Do not bring or wear any jewels or valuables. (The hospital is not responsible for lost or stolen objects.)



BACK HOME

- Limit your activities. Do not exert the member in which the injection was administered for 48 hours after the exam.
- If you have an allergic reaction (skin eruption, rash, nausea, etc.) or have fever accompanied by pain in the infiltrated joint, consult your physician or go to a walk-in clinic. If the clinic is closed, dial 8-1-1 for Info-Santé or go the emergency department of your nearest hospital centre
- If you are diabetic, please note that cortisone can cause your blood-sugar levels to vary or increase.
- The full effects of the medication will usually be felt within 7 to 10 days after the exam.
