

RADIOLOGY | Hysterosalpingography

Your physician has prescribed a hysterosalpingography test. This test involves injecting an iodized contrast dye through a probe into the womb (uterus) to view the uterine cavity and Fallopian tubes. This test is quite useful for examining uterine tube permeability during sterility assessments.

ABOUT THE TEST

- This test is conducted during the first phase of your menstrual cycle (between the 5th and 10th day following the beginning of menstruation). You must call the appointment centre of the medical imaging department on the first (1st) day of your menstrual cycle to schedule the test.
- A gynecologist and/or radiologist assisted by a medical imaging technologist will perform the hysterosalpingography.
- During the test, you will lie on your back in a gynecological position. The test is conducted in sterile conditions. The professionals behave with the utmost tact and discretion.
- The gynecologist and/or radiologist will first insert a speculum into the vagina and then a probe into the uterine cavity. A contrast dye will slowly be injected while the radiologist simultaneously uses X-ray imaging to monitor the flow of the injection.
- Many images will be taken. Once the exam is completed, the probe will be removed.

ALLERGIES | DIABETES

- If you are diabetic or allergic to contrasting dyes (iodine), latex, or lidocaine:
- Inform your physician. He will give you specific instructions to follow.
- Notify the administrative officer who will call you to confirm your appointment.
- Furthermore, upon arriving at the medical imaging department, notify the technologists.

PREPARING FOR THE TEST

- It is important to urinate before the test.
- Recent chlamydia screening with a negative result is required by your physician before the test.
- One hour before the test, as needed, you may take a painkiller (the same one you normally use for menstrual pain).
- Bring feminine hygiene products (sanitary pads) to the exam as you might experience discharge after the test.

ON THE DAY OF THE TEST

- The examination lasts 15 to 20 minutes; however, the entire appointment may last one to two hours.
- You will be asked to put on a hospital gown.
- Do not hesitate to ask the technologists any question you may have during the examination.

BRING THE FOLLOWING TO THE EXAMINATION

- A valid health insurance card (to avoid paying for this test).
- A valid hospital card (if needed, you will have to go to the reception and admitting department to get a card before your appointment).
- A list of your medications, if requested.
- A bag for your personal items. Do not bring or wear any jewels or valuables. (The hospital is not responsible for lost or stolen objects.)
- Feminine hygiene products (sanitary pads).



AFTER THE EXAMINATION

- It is perfectly normal to experience cramps at the abdominal level. You may take a painkiller (the same one you normally use for menstrual pain).
- If you have discharge after the test, use a feminine hygiene product (sanitary pad). The discharge can last one to two days and may be accompanied by blood loss.
- If you have an allergic reaction (rash, redness, nausea, etc.) or have fever, consult your physician or go to a walk-in clinic. If the clinic is closed, dial 8-1-1 for Info-Santé or go the emergency department of your nearest hospital centre.
